

Dress Guidelines

Remember that you are a minister representing Jesus Christ.

Here are some general guidelines that may help you in deciding what attire would be appropriate. However, there are some situations, which you may have to use personal discretion. All that we ask is that you dress modest and tasteful.

Sunday Morning Service

Please dress your best for this service. No tee shirts, sweatshirts, or gym pants are allowed at Sunday services.

Daily Sessions, Night Sessions, and Wednesday night Events

Please dress casual but nice. You may wear T-shirts, sweatshirt, sweater, etc.

Miscellaneous

There will be times, such as drama, music practice, or during travel, where the dress code may be changed. However, we will inform you of any changes prior to the occasion. When you are allowed to wear shorts, we ask that they would be a modest length.

Please keep your clothing washed and pressed so that your appearance will always be neat and presentable. Often times we will wear a type of team uniform when ministering which will consist of nice jeans and a “Merge” shirt.

Dress reveals things about the person. I realize that in this day, there is relatively little importance placed on clothes. However, that does not change the teaching of the Bible. The Bible teaches that clothing originated with God. (Genesis 3: 7, 21) Clothing makes a statement, as we shall see and is of great importance.

Piercings/Tattoos

You will not be permitted to get piercings or tattoos throughout the school year. If you already have a piercing or tattoo prior to school that is fine. However, be aware that some of the events and church services we may require you to take out your piercing or cover your tattoo.

Natural highlights or natural hair dyes only. Neon/pastel colors in your hair are not permitted.
